Whether done with old fashion metal taps and a metal bucket or the new plastic taps that hook into plastic tubing, the sap will be running and the new maple syrup once known as liquid gold will be ready.

On the Saturday and Sunday March 24th and 25th , Fleischmanns First, for the seventh year, will host its Maple Festival to celebrate the new season's maple syrup production with a weekend full of activities and events inspired by and celebrating the tradition of turning maple sap into maple syrup!
